

## Fees and Charges Information Sheet Smart and Skilled

### FEES AND CHARGES

New South Wales (NSW) Smart and Skilled is a reform of the NSW Vocational Education and Training system. It provides eligible students with:

- An entitlement to government-subsidised training up to and including Certificate III
- Government funding for higher level courses (Certificate IV and above) in targeted priority areas

If you are

- Living or working in NSW
- An Australian citizen, permanent Australian resident, humanitarian visa holder or New Zealand Citizen
- 15 year old or older
- No longer in secondary education (high school)
- Registered as a NSW apprentice or new entrant trainee

You could be eligible for this funding.

### FEE FREE TRAINEESHIPS

The NSW Government is currently funding more than 390 traineeship courses in a range of industries. If you are eligible to for this Fee Free Traineeship funding, you will not be charged a Student Fee.

To be eligible, your training needs to be funded under the NSW Governments Smart and Skilled Program and your commencement date must be on or after 1 January 2020.

### FEE INCLUSIONS

Course fees represent the total cost to enrol, undertake training and receive certification and covers:

- Enrolment fees
- Administration/accounting and processing fees
- Learning materials essential to achieving competence
- The development of a training plan if applicable
- The LLN assessment
- The undertaking of the training (2 attempts before additional fees apply)
- The issuance of one (1) copy of the relevant Certificate/Statement of Attainment upon completion or withdrawal from training (Replacement certificates \$27.50 inc GST)
